<b>Courses</b>	<b>Descriptions:</b>
ECON 6570 - Industrial Organization	This course presents economic models of antitrust and regulation. The course is divided into roughly three sections: the economics of imperfectly competitive markets, the regulation of these imperfect competitive markets in the context of antitrust law, and the regulation of markets with regard to social policy goals.
ECON 6580- Topics in International Economics	This course covers three areas in international finance: (1) Money and exchange rates, (2) the balance of payments, and (3) the role of policy. Upon completion of this course, you should be able to apply theory in contexts related to international economics and become familiar with the important data sources to the topic and institutional players in the field of international economics.
